to tell the wonderful things God has done."

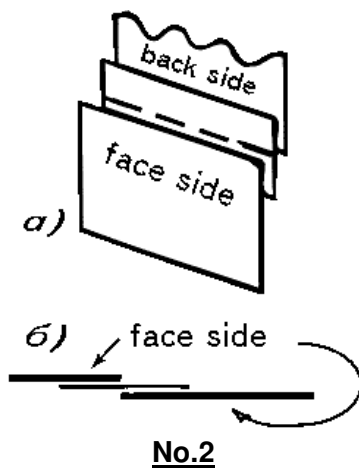
This is the Word of the Lord. *Thanks be to God.*

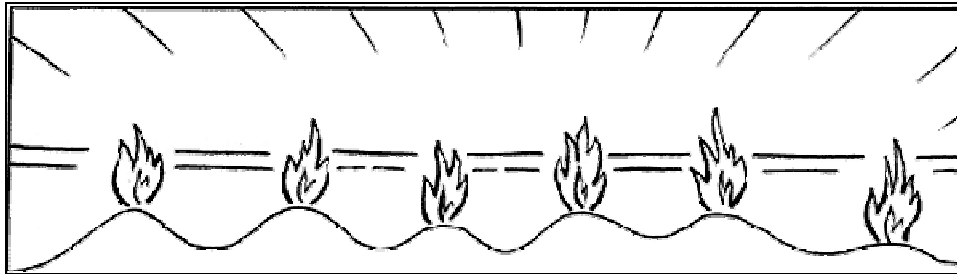
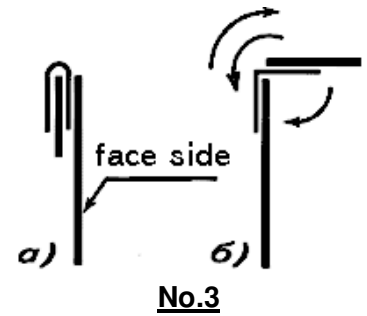


Instructions:

3. Glue this strip to the back side of pictures 1 and 2 (no. 2) so that you could easily turn picture 2 back and forth (no.3) and when you turn it forward the flames of fire were above the heads of disciples.
